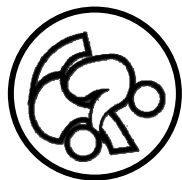

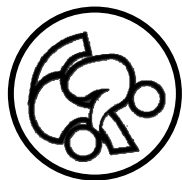

Age Bands	Pre-Cadets must be born in 2005 or 2006. Cadets must be born in 2002, 2003 or 2004. Minimum grade: Green belt Contest Duration: 3 minutes for Pre-Cadets and 4 minutes for Cadets
Competition Format, Rules and Judogi Rules	Format will be compound repechage if 8 or more entries and pools to crossover or single pool if fewer than 8. This is a BJA Level Three event for Pre-Cadets. Strangles and armlocks are NOT allowed. Positive coaching will be allowed throughout the contest for Pre-Cadets. This is a BJA Level Four event for Cadets. For Cadets, IJF rules will be in force with the following exceptions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 30 second rule will NOT be in force. • Judogi measurements are as per 2016 IJF rules, but the Red Label rules or the need to wear judogi of specified manufacturers will NOT be in force. • There will be NO IJF random weight checks. • Matside coaching will ONLY be allowed between mate and hajime, whether from the coach's chair or adjacent to the mat area. Blue and white judogi are not required. If you bring a blue judogi, you MUST also bring a white one.
Seeding	The top eight players in the Cadet Identification list will be seeded. There will be no seeding in Pre-Cadets.

Note: weigh-in times may be revised if entries dictate, in which case we will contact all clubs entered.

Notes

Each team should start with three players. If there are 2 players their combined weight must be no more than 75% of the total weight and the weight "missing" will decide which position in the team is vacant. Players below the minimum weight shall be deemed the minimum weight. Teams fight in weight order, lightest first. Players can fight in more than one category (e.g. Boys LW and Boys HW) if they meet the criteria but they may not fight in two teams in the same category. All players in boys and girls teams must be under 16 years of age (minimum age 8) on the day and seniors must be at least 14 years of age on the day. All players must possess a valid, in date BJA licence or equivalent and must wear white judogi. Method of competition will be pools, K.O. and repechage. BJA Level three point scoring event. There will be a "Swap Shop" board for any teams lacking a player or players looking to enter a team on the day. BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to all Junior Lightweight teams, irrespective of age or grade.

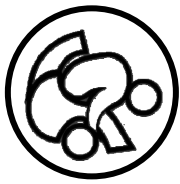

Dan Grade Theory Course & Exam

Sunday 24th March 2019

Samurai Judo Club, Zortech Avenue, Kidderminster DY11 7DY

The course, run by Ben Newbury, will cover all of the requirements for contest dan grade theory up to 4th dan going for 5th dan. Candidates are advised, however, that there is a lot to take in and they should make some attempt to learn what they can before the course. In one day, a course can only act as a refresher and a clarification of areas of confusion and the less well known techniques, as well as explaining what examiners look for. A partner is useful but not essential.

Once the single techniques and one set of each type of combinations have been covered, 1st kyu players can take the examination. The examiner will be Andrew Haffner, Senior Examiner 195 (who was part of the panel which revised the dan grade syllabus and is chair of the National Promotions Commission). Meanwhile 1st dan players will go through another set of combinations, after which they can take their exam, and so on. The course will include a brief overview of a set of nage no kata for each dan grade (the 3rd set for 1st dan, the 2nd set for 2nd dan, the 1st set for 3rd dan) and a set of katame no kata for 3rd dan (the 2nd set, shimewazas), but candidates should have studied some kata before the day in order to do well. It is recommended that candidates seeking 3rd, 4th or 5th dan should have attended a prior kata course unless they are experienced in kata; we will only have time to briefly revise the kata on this course.

There is no guarantee that candidates will pass the exam, but our courses do have a very good history of preparing candidates well, as well as being related to contest and technical judo and hopefully being informative, interesting and friendly. As well as being competitive 4th dan with outstanding knowledge of the syllabus, Ben is a BJA National B Referee and former British Kata Champion and has run many similar successful courses in the past.

Candidates seeking technical dan grade exams can be examined on the day, but the course will not cover the specific requirements.

Eligibility: players must currently hold the grade below the grade they are going for (e.g. must be 1st kyu if attempting 1st dan theory) and must hold current BJA membership which must be produced on the day. Only one theory grade can be examined on the day – for example, players cannot do both 1st dan and 2nd dan theory.

Being a technical official can be of great benefit to your club – and you get one of the best seats at a competition from which to watch the judo!

Requirements to sit exam

Level	Minimum Age	Minimum Judo Grade	BJA membership
Contest Recorder (CR)	16 Years	None required	None required
Senior Recorder (SR)	18 Years	None required	Recreational (or full) licence

Other Requirements

Candidates should have done at least 4 events since their last qualification.

Candidates for CR do not need to have previously gained Timekeeper award, but if not should have a good understanding of judo terms and should preferably (but not essentially) have had some experience of working on a table at an event (which could include a dan grading).

Notes

There will be 2 courses running simultaneously, 1 for CR and 1 for SR. Candidates can only sit one course and exam. It is possible (and preferable) to qualify as Timekeeper (TK) “on the job” prior to the day and then go for CR.

Those wishing to take the courses **MUST** register in advance.

Bring a notebook and Pen (no judogi required). Anybody may sit the CR course, parents and non-players are welcome.

Examinees for senior recorder must hold a current BJA membership to take the assessment at the end of the course (not required for CR). There is no grade requirement for the qualifications; indeed, you don't need to have done judo at all to become a Technical Official, although familiarity with referees' words and signals will help.
